Casey North Community Information & Support Service (CNCISS) provides a range of support programs and information services, staffed by both professional workers and trained volunteers. All services provided are free and confidential. Areas covered vary from program to program, see below;

Emergency Relief

Assistance provided to households in severe financial hardship and unable to purchase essential items such as food, medicine and other essential services. Shower packs and vouchers also available for the homeless.

Support Program

Social Work/Case Work Provides support to people in crisis or needing assistance with complex issues.

Counselling

Crisis response (4 sessions) available to people needing support through difficult issues and/or situations.

Workshops can be tailored to suit any group; Money management/budgeting, saving money on utility bills, debt and consumer credit, fines, your rights, resources & assistance available. Showbags provided.

No Interest Loan Scheme
